**Project Location (include county):** The project is located in the North Fork tributary to Deep Creek, at 35100 Highway 18 in Running Springs, County of San Bernardino, State of California; Latitude: 34.132952 N, Longitude: -117.2978 W. The project includes two catch basins along the west edge of the Snow Valley Mountain Resort. The first basin is located near the entrance to the ski resort (Basin 1) and the second is located at the downstream end of the parking lot (Basin 2).
