The City of Torrance has determined that a project application is complete for a proposed industrial development project (Case Nos. CUP20-01003, DIV20-01002 and EAS20-01001).

Below please find a description of the proposed project, a map showing the project location, and the name of our project point of contact, pursuant to PRC § 21080.3.1 (d).

Project Description: The proposed light industrial project provides for the construction of one (1) warehouse building totaling 305,550 square feet located on a 13.29-acre site resulting in an overall Floor Area Ratio (FAR) of 0.53. The single industrial building will be supported by truck yards, vehicular parking/drive aisles and landscaping. The majority of the parking proposed is at grade. The project includes a Division of Lot to consolidate three existing parcels into one to locate the project entirely on one parcel resulting in a FAR that does not exceed 0.60.
