The applicant seeks approval to modify Development Plan County File #DP88-3007 to allow life safety repairs of the existing, primary driveway structure for the Atria Park Lafayette assisted living facility (constructed in year 2003), including installation of new soldier pile retaining walls with concrete cribbing and tie rods (maximum height 30 feet) along either side of the existing 250-linear-foot driveway, approximately 2,100 cubic yards of cut/fill grading, enlargement of the existing box culvert beneath the driveway to a maximum height of 19 feet and length of 64 feet, replacement of the existing roadway surface.
