**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number LAK-09296-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Charleen Wignall.

The project is limited to the operation of a single surface water diversion to irrigate cannabis. Surface water will only be diverted between November 1 and March 31 of each year. Water will be diverted from the stream into an off stream storage pond and 38 – five-thousand-gallon tanks for later use to irrigate cannabis.
