Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration, Notice of Proposed Section 4(f) *De Minimis* determination and virtual open house for the Fish Creek Fish Passage project

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is proposing a project to replace an existing reinforced concrete box culvert with a 32-foot-wide by 42-footlong bridge to remediate the fish passage barrier on Fish Creek on State Route 254 (Avenue of the Giants) at post mile 4.18.
