Thank you for your interest in the Alpine County Park. Alpine Community Park will be on the agenda for the November 8, 2023 County Board of Supervisors meeting. Materials for the hearing have now been posted on our website here <u>Alpine</u> <u>Community Park (sdparks.org)</u> for review prior to the Board meeting. Please note that as described in the Board Letter for this item, the Alpine County Park is planned to be constructed in phases with Phase 1 moving forward at this time. Phase 1 is planned to include the following components: main entrance to the park, a dog park, playgrounds, picnic areas, an equestrian staging area, a community garden, sports courts, park office and restrooms, a volunteer pad, and parking. Future phases of the project, which are not funded at this time, will include: a multi-purpose grass area, baseball field, all-wheel area, bike skills course, fitness stations, multi-purpose building, a second restroom, and additional trails and parking.

 - You can also use your Request to Speak form to write an opinion and not speak.
