Request for a Use Permit for 2,000 square feet of indoor cannabis cultivation in a 2,000 square foot agriculture structure (barn) on a 60.58-acre parcel. The proposed project would also include construction of a 100-square foot ADA compliant bathroom. The project would operate between 9:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday. The project would employ 4-full time employees. The site is closed to the public. The project would be located at 205 Deer Creek Lane, Petaluma on a mostly undeveloped 60.58-acre parcel zoned Land Extensive Agriculture, B6 Combining District, Riparian Corridor and Scenic Resources.
