The Project would improve the long-term water management and habitat value of the San Joaquin Marsh Reserve. The Project proposes new and repairs of existing hydrology and water quality infrastructure to better manage flows within the Marsh Reserve. Design Goal 1 proposes infrastructure establishment and/or modifications that anticipate impacts of climate change (e.g., drought, flooding, and sea level rise). Design Goal 2 focuses on water sourcing, treatment, and measurement (from Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) or San Diego Creek). Construction is anticipated to take approximately 8 to 10 months total and may occur in two phases, likely one phase for Design Goal 1 and one phase for Design Goal 2. The Marsh Reserve would continue to function as a preservation area during and after construction.
