The location of the proposed Project is a 38-acre parcel owned by TID that lies adjacent to the Ceres Main Canal and Lower Lateral 3 Canal, 0.25 mile south of Keyes Road and 0.25 mile west of Prairie Flower Road in Stanislaus County. The proposed Project would involve removing existing facilities, almond trees, and the top 1 foot of native soil from the 38-acre proposed Project site. The proposed Project site would then be graded and the regulating reservoir would be constructed by creating compacted earthen fill embankments near the site's perimeter. The interior banks and floor of the reservoir would be lined with 3-inch-thick fiber reinforced concrete. A 30-foot by 40-foot reinforced concrete pump station, powered by electricity, would be constructed at the southeast corner of the proposed Project site. Two 72-inch-diameter, reinforced concrete pipes would connect the pump station and sump area to an adjacent 18-foot by 30-foot, reinforced concrete inlet and outlet structure on the Ceres Main Canal.
