Project Title: City of Orange Wells PFAS Water Treatment Plant Project

Project Locations: The Project would consist of facilities that would be located at four (4) separate locations in the City of Orange as detailed below.

- Well No. 9. An existing potable well site owned by the City of Orange located at 1709 W. Katella Avenue in the City of Orange. The well site is surrounded by commercial land uses and would occur within an existing developed production well site.
- Well No. 19. An existing potable well site owned by the City of Orange located at 2930 E. Collins Avenue in the City of Orange. The well site is located at the rear of a City of Orange Fire Station #2.
- Well No. 23. An existing potable well site owned by the City of Orange located east of the easternmost terminus of East Walnut Avenue near the intersection of East Walnut Avenue and Prospect Avenue. The well site is located east of a channelized portion of Santiago Creek with residences to the west.
- Well No. 24. An existing potable well site owned by the City of Orange located at 637 W. Struck Avenue in the City of Orange. The existing well site is surrounded by commercial land uses.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The Project consists of the installation of small treatment plants at each of the four existing City of Orange groundwater production well sites for the treatment of PFAS contaminants. The treatment plants would use an ion exchange (IX) treatment protocol through the use of cartridge filtration and IX vessels. New cartridge filters and IX treatment vessels would be installed at all four well sites. A new booster pump would be added at well site 24 to accommodate the changed hydrologics introduced by the treatment facility. Each of the four sites have been previously disturbed by the development of the existing groundwater production wells, the Project would not require any new ground disturbances. The facilities would treat water pumped from the existing production wells and would convey it to existing water distribution pipelines for potable water consumption. The Project would not require any native vegetation removal and each facility is located within urbanized portions of the City of Orange.
