Project Title: Arcata/Eureka Fiber Optic Cable Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-13723-R1)

Project Location: The project is located within the Humboldt Bay watershed on tributary streams between the towns of Arcata and Eureka, County of Humboldt, State of California; All activities will take place in the public right of way of Myrtle Avenue, Old Arcata Road and the City of Arcata; latitude/longitude 40.86663, -124.08196 at the first stream crossing.

Project Description: This Agreement relies on the Notification materials and a desk review without a CDFW site inspection. The project is limited to 10 encroachments (Table 1) for horizontal direction drilling (HDD) under streams in order to install a fiber optic cable and associated infrastructure. The entire project will be constructed underground using trenchless methods, such as the HDD construction method. The project consists of a single bore path from an existing facility in Arcata, continues along the eastern side of Humboldt Bay and terminates at an existing substation just east of Eureka.
