Six (6) public comments and seven (7) phone calls from surrounding property owners were received raising concerns mainly regarding traffic impacts. The proposed Project is anticipated to generate fewer than 100 peak hour trips during both the AM and PM peak hours. Per County's traffic study guidelines, local parks are not required to complete a VMT and as presented in the traffic letter, this sport fields park is going to generate less than 100 trips for peak am/pm hours. However, mitigation measure TRAN-1, and TRAN-2 as recommended will be incorporated as conditions of approval for
the project. A traffic study was not required.
