Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The District proposes to build a now crossing next to an existing, structurally unsafe, crossing over the Calaveras River in unincorporated San Joaquin County, California. The purpose of this Project is to provide safe vehicle access for private land owners and for District maintenance purposes. The proposed Project is needed because the existing bridge is structurally unsafe, providing a hazard to anyone who uses it.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

This Project is not anticipated to have significant effects. Best management practices and avoidance and minimization measures will occur throughout the Project. The Project is anticipated to have temporary and permanent impacts to the disturbed riparian corridor. The temporary impacts to the disturbed riparian corridor include approximately 0.022 acres for clearing and grubbing for construction access. This area would be restored upon completion of the Project. There will be two trees removed that currently provide shade over the river, however, the new bridge will provide approximately 0.007 acres of shade over the river. The Project will not have impacts to the Calaveras river, therefore direct impacts to special status fish species is not anticipated nor were any special status species found during the special status species survey.
