Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0261-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Lake California property Owner's Association, as represented by Scott Nielsen.

The project involves annual the dredging and removal of sediment from the Lake California boat launch facility on the Sacramento River. Each year, sediment that has deposited at the facility will be removed from the ramp, within the harbor, and at the mouth of the harbor where it enters the river. The amount of material to be removed will vary from year to year. The estimated annual amount of sediment removal from the site is approximately 200 to 300 cubic yards on a wet year and less on a dry year. Sediment removal work would occur on an annual basis.
