5,	Description of nature, purpose, and beneficiaries of Project:	The purpose of this project is to replace aged asbestos concrete pipe. Due to the age and materials used, the sections of water pipelines described below experience numerous leaks that require a large amount of maintenance time as measured by District Operations staff. As shown on Figure 1, the water pipeline replacement project entails the following improvements:
		Reagan Road: Replace approximately 2,230 LF of 12-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 12-inch diameter PVC waterline from El Palomino Drive to Lakaren Lane.
		Rochelle Court: Replace approximately 216 LF of 8-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 8-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road to the

- end of Rochelle Court.
- 3. Courtney Circle: Replace approximately 213 LF of 8-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 8-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road to the end of Courtney Circle.
- Marcia Court: Replace approximately 209 LF of 8-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 8-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road to the end of Marcia Court.
- Sara Court: Replace approximately 207 LF of 8inch diameter ACP pipeline with 8-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road to the end of Sara Court.
- 6. Jennifer Lane: Replace approximately 254 LF of 8-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 8-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road to the end of Jennifer Lane, and replace approximately 231 LF of 12-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 12-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road. to Linares Avenue.
- Karianne Lane: Replace approximately 331 LF of 8-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 8-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road to the end of Karianne Lane.
- 8. Darcee Drive: Replace approximately 324 LF of 8-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 8-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road to the end of Darcee Drive.
- 9. Lakaren Lane: Replace approximately 302 LF of 8-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 8-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road to the end of Lakaren Lane and replace approximately 201 LF of 12-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 12-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road. to Linares Ave within the 1100 Foot Pressure Zone. Replace approximately 210 LF of 12-inch diameter ACP pipeline with 12-inch diameter PVC waterline from Reagan Road to Linares Avenue within the 970 Foot Pressure Zone.

The project consists of trenching, backfill and compaction work to facilitate the replacement of existing water pipelines and connections to JCSD's existing water system. Restoration of surfaces to their original condition will be performed as well as protection of existing above and below grade facilities and utilities.

Beneficiaries of the project are Jurupa Community Service District customers, which include residential and commercial uses.

Reason	why pro	ject was exempt:	The proposed project is part of JCSD's annual water pipeline replacement program and will replace a total of approximately 4,928 LF of existing ACP pipeline with PVC waterline within the public rights-of-way. Specifically, the project will replace approximately 2,056 LF of 8-inch and 2,872 LF of 12-inch diameter waterlines as described above and shown on Figure 1—Vicinity Map and Project Location. The Statutory Exemption set forth in PRC §21080.21, exempts project is applicable to "any project of less than one mile in length within a public street or highway or any other public right-of-way for the installation of a new pipeline or the maintenance, repair, restoration, reconditioning, relocation, replacement, removal, or demolition of an existing pipeline." Pipeline for this statutory exemption subsurface facilities but does not include any surface facility related to the operation of the underground facility. All of the pipeline replacements are within public ROW and the total length of pipeline being replaced is less than one mile. Thus, the exemption set forth in PRC §21080.21 is applicable to the project. The project's replacement of existing, aged ACP water pipelines with the same sized PVC waterlines is further categorically exempt from CEQA under the Class 2 exemption set forth in State CEQA Guidelines §15302, which exempts the "replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new

		structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced." Here, new PVC waterlines will replace existing ACP pipelines; the replacement PVC waterlines will be located within the same public ROWs as the existing ACP waterlines and will have the same purpose and capacity as the ACP pipelines to be replaced. (CEQA Guidelines §15302(c).	
		Finally, none of the exceptions to the categorical exemptions apply here. The Project will not have any cumulative impacts; there is no reasonable possibility that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances; the Project does not affect any scenic highways or historical resources, and it is not located on a hazardous waste site.
