Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The proposed project would involve an agreement to install and operate eight (8) wall mounted electric vehicle (EV) charging stations in the San Diego Convention Center parking garage. The agreement would commence on October 6, 2020 for a term of five (5) years with the option for two 1-year renewals. The EV charging stations would be located within the underground garage adjacent to the 5th Avenue entrance, near the southeast end of level P1 and replace older technology previously installed but already removed from the site. Each proposed EV charging station has dimensions of approximately 4.13"x5.75"x2.24" and energy specifications of Level 2, 220V, 30 AMP, and 6.6 kW. One (1) of the eight (8) EV charging stations would be located in an ADA parking space.

Installation of the eight (8) EV charging stations would occur within 60 days of execution of the agreement and be completed within two weeks by two to three workers. Installation activities involve attaching the units to the wall and running wires through the existing conduit to the power supply. There will be no trenching because all wires are external. The units would be in operation by early 2021.
