The Department has reviewed the Mitigated Negative Declaration dated April 8, 2021, for the above-referenced project (Project). The Department's review of this Project is pursuant to our role as the State's trustee and responsible agency for fish and wildlife resources under the California Environmental Quality Act, California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq. The Project proposes to subdivide an approximately 39.93-acre lot into two lots of 17.72 acres and 22.22 acres. Each lot would include existing single-gamily residences with driveway access at the terminus of Dreamcatcher Lane along with rural residential land uses and remaining agricultural lands; the east side of each lot would be adjacent to Cow Creek and its riparian habitat areas. The Project is located in Palo Cedro on Assessor's Parcel Numbers 058-120-014 and 058-120-003.

The Department commented on this Project on January 23, 2020, during early consultation. Based on the mitigation measures incorporated and the information provided, the Department has no comments at this time.
