DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Rehabilitate over three phases, the Kiln West hillside area that was burned in the 2019 Hollow Fire in order to prevent potential soil loss and improve habitat for wildlife. Work will:

- Add approximately 1200 cubic yards total of soil with a ten-yard dump truck: up to 240 T of fill within the Phase 1 project area of 0.60 acres, up to 276 T of fill within the Phase 2 project area of 0.70 acres, and up to 684 T of fill within the Phase 3 project area of 1.70 acres;
- Use a SWECO and Water truck for dust control and compaction;
- Use hand tools and a mechanical t-post bounder to install t-posts every 10 feet and approximately 6,100 feet of wire fencing total;
- Excavate gate post holes (2 per gate) with dimensions of four inches in diameter and two feet in depth;
- Install eight gates total: four along Los Osos trail, three along Los Osos Back trail, and one where Kiln Trail meets Grizzly; and
- Install Storm Water BMPs wattles, hydromulch, and native grass seed on rehabbed areas in each of the three phases.
