Annexation approval by the Solano Local Agency Formation Commission in to the Rural North Vacaville Water District is required prior to final map recordation process and sale of each individual lots.

Property is located within a groundwater scarce zone; therefore, public water service connection should mitigate impacts to less than significant level.

There are clusters of heritage sized Blue Oaks and Interior Live Oaks on the property. To protect the heritage size trees, development, construction or trenching within 5 feet of the dripline is prohibited.

To protect Migratory Bird Species, preconstruction surveys are recommended during the nesting season (Feb 1 - August 31).

The property is located high in the valley and construction noise may cause significant impacts, construction activities are limited to weekdays during the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday; and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturdays, and no work should occur on Sundays and Federal holidays.
