#### NOTICE

Each project applicant shall remit to the county clerk the environmental filing fee before or at the time of filing a Notice of Determination (Pub. Resources Code, § 21152; Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subdivision (d); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 753.5). Without the appropriate fee, statutory or categorical exemption, or a valid No Effect Determination issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), the Notice of Determination is not operative, vested, or final, and shall not be accepted by the county clerk.

#### **COUNTY DOCUMENTARY HANDLING FEE**

The county clerk may charge a documentary handling fee of fifty dollars (\$50) per filing in addition to the environmental filing fee (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (e); Cal. ## **Project Location:**

## **Background:**

Thornton's Well Number 2 (Well #2) is within County Service Area 12 (CSA 12) and was installed soon after the formation of the CSA 12 district in 1978. CSA 12 provides water service to approximately 190 properties within the district boundary.

There is currently no alternative power source for Well #2 due to the failure of the existing generator resulting in water service interruptions for the residents in Thornton during times of power failure.

1. Rehabilitating the emergency power generator at CSA 12 Well #2. All work will be inside the facility.


## **Environmental Setting:**

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Since all work will be done inside the facility and will not approach any of the nearby trees, a pre-construction survey is not needed.


## **Beneficiaries:**
