The City of La Cañada Flintridge has received an application for a General Plan Amendment, Zone Change, Density Bonus, and Conditional Use Permit to allow construction of a new three-story development project located at 600 Foothill Blvd, La Cañada Flintridge, CA 91011. The City serves as the lead agency for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for this project. We are sending this notification to you pursuant to Assembly Bill 52, which requires agencies to consult with Native American tribes for the purposes of mitigating impacts to tribal cultural resources.

The proposed project includes an approximately 77,310 square foot, three-story building with senior apartments that will be age-restricted to individuals aged 55 years old and over, 12 hotel units, approximately 7,600 sf of office use and one level of subterranean parking. The project site is a 1.29-acre property with an existing church located at the southwest corner of Foothill Boulevard and Woodleigh Lane, within the boundaries of the City of La Cañada Flintridge (see enclosed map). The Initial Study process for the proposed project has begun and it is anticipated that a Mitigated Negative Declaration will be completed for the project.

To ensure compliance with Assembly Bill 52 (Public Resources Code Sections 21080.3.1 and 21080.3.2), the City requested a list of California Native American tribes that are traditionally and culturally affiliated with the geographic area of the proposed project from the Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC). Your contact information was provided and I am requesting information on any cultural resources you have knowledge of within the project site vicinity. Alternatively, if you would like to request consultation with the City of La Cañada Flintridge regarding the proposed project, please do so within 30 days.

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
