

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The City of San Marcos intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (ND21-001) for the project described below. PROJECT NO.: SP19-0004, GPA19-0004, R19-0002, CUP19-0011, & ND21-001

APPLICANT: Carkel San Marcos, LLC- Starbucks

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT: Request for a proposed 1,797 square-foot drive-thru coffee shop with an approximately 331 square-foot outdoor dining area on a 0.55-acre property. The project includes a Specific Plan Amendment, General Plan Amendment and Rezone to change the land use designation and zone of the property from San Marcos Creek Specific Plan Area (SPA) to Commercial (C), and a Conditional Use Permit for review of the proposed project design. Project includes the installation of 300 feet of 8-inch sewer pipeline within Bent Avenue.

LOCATION: Southeast corner of San Marcos Blvd. and Bent Ave. Assessor's Parcel Number(s): 219-270-06-00.

MND PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD: From May 10, 2021 to June 9, 2021.


PUBLIC HEARING DATE: A public hearing date has not been scheduled at this time.
