Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number LAK-21213-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Elli Hagoel.

The proposed project involves the filling of four existing unnamed drainages leading to Schindler Creek and the construction of a new drainage channel around three cannabis cultivation pads on the property. Project activities include restoring the bank of the unnamed tributary in two locations due to trenching activities, decommissioning and reseeding all low water crossings used to access the cultivation sites, rerouting water off the cultivation pads by establishing a new channel with connectivity to the unnamed tributary to Schindler Creek, and replacing five undersized culverts.
