Project Title: Cady Ranch Water Distribution (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SJN-19172-R2)

Project Location (include county): The Project is located adjacent to 28533 East Shelton Road on the Calaveras River, in the City of Plymouth, County of Amador, State of California: Latitude 38.06301, Longitude -120.96071; Section 35, Township 03N, Range 09E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Valley Springs SW, Mount Diablo Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-19172-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Stockton East Water District, as represented by Darrel Evensen.

The Project is limited to the construction and installation of a 27-inch diameter PVC pipe with a fish screen in the Calaveras River, through which water will be drawn by two vertical turbine water pumps to irrigate the adjacent almond orchard. The two water pumps will be constructed atop a concrete pad approximately 60 feet back from the top-of-bank of the Calaveras River. Approximately 384 square feet of rock slope protection (RSP) will be placed on the bank and in the channel around the pump inlet to secure and protect the inlet and fish screen. The fish screen will be made up of size 12 mesh (1.4mm openings) and will be self-cleaning in design.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
