**Project Location (include county):** The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Clover Creek in Shasta County, CA; T31N, R02W, Section 6, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Palo Cedro quadrangle, County Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 093-030-003-000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SHA-18215-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Henry Cotton.

The Project is limited to the operation and maintenance of impoundments and associated infrastructure on an unnamed tributary to Clover Creek. The impoundments and inflow/outflow structures require periodic maintenance to function properly, including removal of sediment and woody debris and replacement of RSP as necessary. Woody debris and sediment obstructing the inlet and outlet will be removed by hand, however heavy machinery such as a backhoe or excavator are required to remove materials from the impoundments. The intended use of impounded water is for aesthetics, wildlife habitat, and emergency fire suppression.
