The Project would redevelop and expand an existing retail shopping center - related approvals include Plot Plan No. 2018-300, Conditional Use Permit Nos. 2018-301 and 2018-302, and Tentative Parcel Map No. 2018-320. The Project would develop a total of 7,581 square feet of new commercial space and a gasoline service station on a 3.8-acre commercial site.
