Project Location: The seven project locations are located along State Route (SR) 49 in Placer County on tributaries to Orr Creek. Locations 1, 2, and 3 are adjacent to the intersection of Lorenson/Florence Road and SR 49. Location 7, 8, 9, and 10 are located adjacent to the intersection of Lone Star Road and SR 49. The project locations extend between post miles 8.7 and 10.6 on SR 49; located approximately 6.5 miles north of the town of Auburn, CA.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has issued Amendment #1 to the Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-27101-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

Amendment #1 increases the permanent habitat impact acreage, renumber the project locations, and adds an additional reporting measure for mitigation.
