NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Dear Property Owner or Agency:

This notice is being sent to property owners within or near the area shaded on the attached map and to all public agencies who are reviewing agencies for this environmental document. The map shows the property, consisting of 10.5 acres, on which City of Redding, Community Services is requesting approval of a site development permit to construct the Panorama Park and Field House on property located at 900 and 950 Lake Boulevard. The application also includes a request to amend the General Plan from "General Office" to "Park" and a Rezoning from "GO" General Office" to "PF" Public Facility on property located at 900 Lake Boulevard consisting of 1.1 acres of land. The site is zoned "GO" General Office and "PF" Public Facility with General Plan designations of "General Office" and "Park."

The City of Redding Planning Division has reviewed the project and, based upon the whole record before the City (including the Initial Study and any supporting documentation), is recommending that a Mitigated Negative Declaration* be adopted pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act.

All interested persons are invited to comment in writing on the draft Mitigated Negative Declaration to the Planning Division prior to the end of the public review period. The comment period begins May 21, 2021 and ends June 21, 2021. The Planning Commission will consider recommending adoption of the Mitigated Negative Declaration to the City Council at a later date. Subsequent notification will be made for all public hearings scheduled for consideration of the environmental document and project approval. Adoption of the Mitigated Negative Declaration will conclude the environmental review of the project.

The Initial Study, site plan, project description, draft Mitigated Negative Declaration, and other information concerning the project is available for public review from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays at the Planning Division, Development Services Department, 777 Cypress Avenue, Redding, CA 96001 (telephone 530-225-4020) and online on the Planning/Projects page of the Development Services website at: www.cityofredding.org. If you challenge the project or decision in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing.
