The project proposes the development of a 12-lot residential community on approximately 3.62 acres of vacant land in the City of Desert Hot Springs. The project will include 12 single family residential units and associated improvements such as paved pedestrian sidewalks and drive aisles, and landscape enhancements. The proposed residential lots will range from 0.207 acres to 0.293 acres. Vehicular access into the project property will occur from one location on Pierson Boulevard. The street will end at the northern portion of the site, in a cul-de-sac, providing access to each residential lot. The project driveway will be complemented by an improved project frontage along Pierson Boulevard, which will include a paved pedestrian sidewalk and landscaping. Landscaped areas are proposed throughout the project site to enhance building frontages and Pierson Boulevard frontage, and pedestrian pathways. The proposed street frontage, buildings and landscaping will be reviewed by the City of Desert Hot Springs. Underground retention chambers are proposed along the internal paved road, and a 6-foot-high block wall is proposed along the perimeter of the project to ensure project privacy and security.
