Project Location: The project is located at the confluence of Natividad, Alisal, Hospital, and Gabilan Creeks (Carr Lake), centered within the city of Salinas, in the County of Monterey, California; Latitude 36°41'22.5198"N, Longitude -121°38'24.8496"W; or Section 00, Township 14 South, Range 3 East, U.S. Geological Survey map Salinas.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-MON-25589-R4), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, The Big Sur Land Trust. The Project includes activities related to the conversion of agricultural plots and channelized ditches into upland grassland, freshwater emergent wetland, riparian tree groves, a seasonal wetland, freshwater shrub wetland, and seasonal wetland grass depressions. The Project will provide public opportunity for nature enjoyment with implementation of bridges, walking trails, an observation deck, a boardwalk, perimeter fencing and improvements to site access.
