The damaged girders were weakened and lacked sufficient strength to support live loads on the portion of the deck above them. This problem was addressed as soon as possible in order to avoid the failure of travel way and/or threat of failure to the transportation system and to prevent or mitigate the loss or impairment of life, health, property, and essential public services.

The scope of work included the following components:

- Installation of a temporary falsework system
- Demolition
- · Repairing two girders
- Spall repair
- Traffic control
- Incidental work

Abatement with the responsible party will be pursued to reimburse the State for the cost of this repair.

Staging

There was only a single stage in which traffic in one direction was reduced to a single lane while repairs took place and occurred entirely within the Caltrans right-of-way. Warning signs will be updated during which time the gore area in front of the bridge will be used as a staging area for the work.

Disposal/Borrow

Based on the scope of the work and due to the nature of the project, a disposal/borrow site was not required.

Right-of-Way

This project was completed within State right-of-way.
