#### Work includes:

- Install concrete sand trap;
- Enlarge infiltration basin to accommodate sediment drop;
- Line infiltration basin with permeable filter fabric and 20 lb rock;
- Rehabilitate, and expand, existing infiltration basin at outlet of sand trap;
- Replace existing gravel berm on southwestern corner of the property with a check dam or gabion structure; and
- Repair spalling/pocked concrete at driveway areas in front of garage and truck wash areas.

### Right-of-Way

Acquisitions or TCEs will not be needed for this project; all work will be completed within State property.

# Staging/Stockpiling

Staging will take place on location at the Alturas Maintenance Station.

#### **Disposal/Borrow Sites**

The project would not utilize borrowed material. If excess material is generated, it will be become property of the contractor. In the event that the contractor does not remove excess material, it will be utilized in place at the maintenance station.
