DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Implement two minor improvements to the existing facilities at the Sacramento State Aquatic Center in Folsom Lake State Recreation Area, to improve traffic flow and accommodate increased visitation. The project includes the following components:

- Widen the right-hand turn from the Aquatic Center entrance road into the main parking lot to improve traffic flow and to facilitate one-direction traffic circulation. This element will saw cut and remove of 60 cubic feet of existing pavement and aggregate base; excavate approximately 246 cubic feet of soils; install and compact a 6-inch layer of aggregate base and a 4-inch layer of asphalt pavement. Work will also relocate a drainage swale along the new outer edge of pavement, relocate stop signs and bollards and restripe pavement.
- Install a concrete pad for, and placement of a prefabricated customer service kiosk in an area of artificial turf to accommodate increased visitation. This work will excavate and remove approximately 108 cubic feet of existing fill (cobble) to a depth 6-8 inches; install and compact approximately 54 cubic feet of imported fill; and pour and finish an 8 x 16foot concrete slab on which the kiosk will be installed.
