DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Conduct a site characterization near a removed leaking underground storage tank (UST) at Smithe Grove Redwoods State Natural Reserve, which is being addressed under the California Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy. Site characterization includes field data collection for soil, groundwater, and surface water that follows the Site Investigation Work Plan prepared in May 2017 for the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board by consultant, Amec Foster Wheeler. Ground disturbance would be associated with up to 7 soil borings that will be up to 20 feet below ground surface. All information will be used to develop a report of the estimated extent of subsurface petroleum hydrocarbons.
