Title: Port of Stockton Rail Bridge Replacement and Rail Improvements Project

Applicant: Port of Stockton

Location: Sovereign land in the San Joaquin River, adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Numbers 145-020-040, -090, and -130; and 162-030-070 in San Joaquin County

Description: The Port of Stockton (Port) is proposing to replace a functionally obsolete rail bridge and construct a new lead track to increase the overall efficiency of train operations within the Port. The proposed rail improvements include replacing the obsolete rail bridge with a new expanded bridge, constructing a new lead track and associated modifications, constructing a new rail underpass, and constructing a new rail classification yard. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through April 3, 2044.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as □Lead Agency ⊠Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on April 4, 2024, and made the following determinations regarding the project.
