The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is proposing to approve a Remedial Action Plan (RAP) for the Former Napa-1 Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) Site (Site) pursuant to regulatory authority granted under Chapter 6.8, Division 20, sections 25323.1 and 25356.1, California Health and Safety Code (H&SC). The Draft RAP proposes to clean contaminated soil and groundwater by conducting soil excavation and off-site disposal, in-situ chemical oxidation of groundwater and in-situ soil stabilization; capping portions of the site with clean soil or hard-cap; post-remediation soil gas and groundwater monitoring;

and institutional controls, including a land use covenant.
