Project Location: The project is located at Costa Creek, a tributary to Pinole Creek, in the County of Contra Costa, State of California; Latitude 37.949544, Longitude -122.189911; Assessor's Parcel Number 365-030-079-5.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number CCA-14666-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Contra Costa County Public Works Department.

The project is limited to the repair and stabilization of two creek bank locations, close in proximity, and the reconstruction of a partially collapsed roadway on Bear Creek Road caused by ongoing creek bank erosion. A 72-foot-long timber lagged soldier pile wall with traffic control features, including a guard rail and minor concrete vegetation control, will be constructed at the northern location. The southern location will be regraded and recompacted with engineered fill, yet also have a guard rail and minor concrete vegetation control installed. The repair will utilize portions of the damaged and existing fall line earthen drainage pattern. A new drainage system will be installed yet will connect to an existing stormwater outfall. Excavated, regraded, and disturbed areas susceptible to erosion will be stabilized with rock slope protection, biodegradable erosion control features, hydroseeding, replanting, and minor pavement repair.
