Project Location (include county): The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Rector Creek in an unincorporated area of Napa County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 032-540-018; Latitude 38.448700°N, Longitude -122.293800°W. Specifically, the project occurs where the unnamed stream flows under a private paved access road to Stagecoach Vineyard.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has issued Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, EPIMS Notification No. NAP-14500-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Gallo Vineyards.

The project is limited to replacing an approximately 58-foot long, 20-foot-wide railroad flatcar bridge with an approximately 68-foot long, 19.5-foot-wide railroad flatcar bridge across an unnamed tributary to Rector Creek. Existing abutments and footings will be abandoned in place to minimize impacts to the bed, bank, and channel. New bridge abutments will be installed behind the existing abutments and outside top-of-bank. The bottom of the new bridge deck will be approximately 2 feet above the estimated 100-year flood water surface elevation.
