To evaluate the impacts of the Pilot Program, an Adaptive Management Plan (AMP) has been prepared. Key components of the AMP are the impact indicators/metrics and measurable standards that Parks staff will monitor on a recurring basis throughout the Pilot Program. The AMP would allow Parks to manage the Pilot Program in a transparent and effective manner. The Mitigated Negative Declaration will be posted on the County Park website https:// parks.smcgov.org/ on July 15, 2021.
