<u>Project Title:</u> Harrison Gulch Fish Passage Project (Project)

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The purpose of the Project is to remediate fish passage barriers to anadromous fish species through improvements to an existing double barrel box culvert on Harrison Gulch, a tributary to Cottonwood Creek. Passage will be improved by converting the left barrel (looking downstream) of the culvert into a specified low flow channel by installing a low flow sill/boulder weir on the concrete apron at the culvert inlet.
