

COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY (NOA) / NOTICE OF INTENT (NOI) TO ADOPT AN INITIAL STUDY / MITIATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION IRON AGE MINE

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the CEQA Guidelines, County Staff prepared a Draft Initial Study / Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) that identify and evaluate the environmental impacts of the Iron Age Mine project.

Project Title: Iron Age Mine

Project Location: 18 miles east/southeast of the City of Twentynine Palms

Project Description: Iron Age Mine, LLC has submitted a Mining and Reclamation Plan to remove historical iron ore tailings on 71 acres of public (BLM) lands and 34 acres of patented (private) lands. The project will reclaim and revegetate 70 acres of prior disturbed land after tailings removal, and backfill 8 acres of the existing quarry.
