CITY OF CHICO CLIMATE ACTION COMMISSION NOTICE OF INTENT TO RECOMMEND ADOPTION OF A NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE CLIMATE ACTION PLAN UPDATE

July 28, 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Chico Climate Action Commission will conduct a meeting on **Thursday September 9, 2021** at **6:00 p.m.** in the City Council Chambers, located at 421 Main Street, regarding the following project:

Climate Action Plan Update – The City of Chico is preparing the Climate Action Plan (CAP) Update to include measures addressing communitywide GHG emissions. Using the 2017 GHG emissions as a baseline, the City is committed to a GHG emissions reduction target of 2.71 metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent (MT of CO2e) per person (or 292,437 MT of CO2e in total emissions) by 2030. This corresponds to an 80 percent reduction in per capita emissions (or a 46 percent reduction in total emissions) below 1990 levels by 2030, exceeding the California Senate Bill 32 target of 40 percent reduction in total emissions by 2030. The Chico 2030 GHG emissions target is selected to be consistent with California Senate Bill 32 State emissions targets and CEQA Guidelines 15183.5 for a qualified GHG emissions reduction strategy, and to be achievable by City-supported measures identified in the Chico CAP Update. To achieve the Chico 2030 GHG emissions target, the CAP Update includes 13 measures related to energy efficiency, renewable energy, sustainable transportation, development patterns, solid waste, water, urban trees and greenspace, and community engagement. The Chico CAP Update applies to all areas and plans/projects within the City of Chico limits.

The City of Chico has prepared a Initial Study and Negative Declaration (IS-ND) for the CAP Update and is requesting comments on the IS-ND and all associated documents, including the CAP Update. The IS-ND addresses the potential physical environmental effects of implementation of the CAP Update in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). As discussed in the IS-ND, the CAP Update was found to result in no significant environmental effect or a less-than-significant environmental effect with regard to all CEQA Guidelines Appendix G environmental topics. No mitigation measures are required.

IS-ND REVIEW PERIOD: The City is soliciting comments on the IS-ND and all associated documents referenced in the IS-ND, including the CAP Update, from **August 3rd, 2021** through **September 2nd, 2021.** Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15074, the City of Chico will consider the IS-ND together with any comments received during the public review process.
