The project would create temporary construction-related air emissions. The Bay Area Air Quality Management District's Basic Construction Mitigation Measures have been added to reduce impacts to a less than significant level. In the event human remains or Native American tribe resources are found, a mitigation measure has been added that requires applicants and contractors must be prepared to carry out the requirements of California State law with regard to the handling such discoveries. Recommendations by the project geotechnical engineer were added as mitigation measures in recognition of its proximity to faults. Mitigation measures are included to control erosion during both project construction activities. To prevent a sight distance issue when exiting the driveway, a mitigation measure was added to add a no parking area to allow for proper visibility.
