CULTURAL:

If project plans change, further studies may be necessary. If previously unidentified cultural resources are unearthed during construction, work shall be halted in that area until a qualified archaeologist can assess the significance of the discovery.

All construction will remain within the road prism. Equipment shall be staged within Caltrans right-of-way in pull out areas adjacent to the roadway. No construction equipment shall be operated or staged within any stream channel, wetland, or other jurisdictional feature.
