Caltrans proposes to use Cold-In-Place Recycling to rehabilitate the pavement stretch off State Route (SR) 16 starting at SR 20 in Colusa County to postmile 0.632 in Yolo County. The scope of work consists of a Partial Depth Recycling of 0.25' which will be capped off with a 0.15' of rubberized hot mix asphalt-gap graded overlay.

All proposed work will occur within Caltrans right of way, including the staging area. No environmental permits, mitigation, or consultation are required. The proposed work will not require any utility relocation or have any excess material to dispose.

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
