Project Location - Specific: Township 23N, Range 11E, Section 12

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The project proposes to repair a storm damaged section of rock slope protection (RSP) on the bank of the Middle Fork Feather River. A 50-foot section of damaged RSP will be replaced with approximately 320 cubic yards of ½ ton RSP, thereby restoring the riverbank segment to its pre-disaster condition. A small portion of the proposed work will occur within the ordinary high water mark (OHWM).

Exempt Status:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from review under CEQA pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Article 19, section 15304, Minor Alterations to Land. Class 4 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry and agricultural purposes.

Reasons why Project is Exempt:

This project is Categorically Exempt under CEQA section 15304 because the project involves minor alterations to land with the placement of 50 linear feet of rip rap with no removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees.
