Project Location (include county): The 903098758 Control Haiwee Remediation Project (project) is located on the north side of Little Lake, approximately 25 miles northwest of Ridgecrest in Inyo County, California, latitude 35.938542 °N, and longitude 117.904930 °W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-INY-19753-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison as represented by Hazem Gabr.
