#### **Description** (Continued from Page 1)

Shop 3 is located at 981 N. Beale Road in Marysville and is included in PG&E's PSPS area. As an Essential Infrastructure Support Operation (EISO), Shop 3 provides regional support and repairs for all Caltrans mobile fleet within its jurisdiction, which extends from the Nevada border to Yolo County, and from South of Elk Grove to Chico. In times of declared emergencies, this facility provides interagency support in the repairs and demobilization of CalFire equipment, or Office of Emergency Services (OES) equipment.

This project was necessary to prevent or mitigate the loss or impairment of life, health, property, or essential services.

The project is located in Yuba County, on Route 70, at postmile 13.24.

The scope of work includes site preparation, installation of the generator system, installation or upgrade of obsolete electrical system, permitting, and incidental work.

#### Right-of-Way

Staging and work occurred within the Caltrans right-of-way (ROW). No ROW relocations, acquisitions, or easements required.

# **Borrow/Disposal**

Disposal at Recology land fill occurred.

#### **Consultation/Coordination**

No need for consultation or agency coordination.

#### **Permits**
