DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Upgrade and repair the Costume Resource Center (CRC) building that houses the living history costume collection located in Columbia State Historic Park to protect the historic building as well as the collection stored within. Work will;

- Reopen a previously boarded up hole in the back door and create a vent in the door for a floor AC unit to operate during hot weather periods;
- · Remove and dispose of failed components of the existing front porch deck;
- Install temporary bracing to stabilize the existing awning structure during deck repair;
- Excavate up to 8" of soil and grade the ground to achieve the desired grade level;
- Install a PT Douglas fir girder and attach 2"x6" PT Douglas fir joists every 16"; and
- Install full dimension rough sawn 2" x 8" x 14' Douglas fir planks with PH aging process application as decking.
