Scope of work:

The project proposes to install an outer separation concrete barrier, replace Metal Beam Guard Rails with separation concrete barriers, widen shoulders, install, replace and update electroliers, and upgrade the drainage system.

Staging

 The staging area is identified in the current project plan, which is within the Caltrans Right-of-Way.

Disposal/Borrow

 The project is expecting to generate approximately 1,500 CY of excess material, which will be relinquished to the contractor for disposal. No borrow would be required.

Right-of-Way
